CRITERIA:

Basis of Evaluation of Exhibits by the Judge:

Educational value (40%)

- Presents suggestions, striking facts or clinching arguments, simple in form, quickly grasped, and ease of accomplishments.
- Shows extent which 4-H involvement meets a fundamental need.
- Promotes decision and action; for example, yields, savings, increased returns, and other benefit which adoption of practice(s) represents.

Interests and Originality (20%)

- Presents original, unusual, or striking method of exhibition.
- Use life, motion, action, color, or light to emphasize the main idea presented.
- Holds interest of people until they have read or observed essentials of the materials presented.
- Uses familiar illustrative material.
- Uses method demonstration or simple contrast.
- Defines clearly one central idea.

Appearance (20%)

- General appearance, artistic, neat, and attractive.
- Title sign showing subject of exhibit.

Quality of Display Material (20%)

- Maps, labels, charts designed to feature effectively the work or practice presented. Consider size of letter and cards in relation to importance of idea.
- Quality of products grown or articles made
