“Learn by doing” is the motto of 4-H. This means both youth and adults learn about group and leadership skills, community involvement and personal development through project, club and countrywide events.

“You get out of 4-H what **you** put into it” means 4-H families have **responsibilities** as well as **opportunities**. They include:

- Select, complete and share your project work (members can purchase 4-H manuals or use other resources)
- Keep in mind that parents are often the primary teachers for project(s) selected
- Attend and participate in a majority of club meetings with project reports, demonstrations, and being a good group member
- Assist with monthly meetings, programs and county wide responsibilities assigned to your club
- Participate in as many county wide events as possible

The 4-H year is September 1st - August 31th. To enroll youth must attend a fall club meeting and complete enrollment forms by December 1st. Strong clubs have the involvement of each family, so find one that best fits your family's schedule.
