JUNIOR HONOR AWARD MEMBER – Minimum 12 items to receive a t-shirt of which 4 must be under club and 4 under county. Eight to 13 years old as of January 1 of the current year. A Junior Honor Award Member must be able to check **12** of the items to receive their t-shirt at Recognition Night.

SENIOR HONOR AWARD MEMBER – Minimum 18 items to receive a sweatshirt. Must be 14 years and older as of January 1 of the current year enrolled. A Senior Honor Award must be able to check **18** of the items listed, of which at least 5 from club, 5 from county and 2 under district and/or state. Those qualifying will be awarded a sweatshirt at Recognition Night.
