Program at a glance... Garden N' Grow is an educational opportunity developed by University of Missouri Extension that blends positive youth development and academic learning with horticulture training and community service. The program encourages the discovery of science and nature through gardening. Gardeners plant and care for their garden plots of vegetables. They are guided by adult educators and Master Gardeners. Development of the whole child is emphasized, as well as team building. Theme gardens such as salsa, weird, sunshine, and holiday are used to teach youth new concepts and skills. Gardening activities promote a sense of ownership, pride and responsibility.
