Conditions of Sale:

- 1. Each member is required to contact five potential buyers and submit their names and addresses to the Extension Office by the required date. Please print complete, accurate, readable names and addresses for potential buyers. We must be able to read names and addresses for future mailings.**
2. A fee of 3% of the sell price will be deducted to help defray sale expenses.
3. In order to retain the right to exhibit at the Missouri State Fair the member must have a signed contract between buyer and seller prior to collecting the sell proceeds. Forms are available in the Extension Office.
4. 4-H members must have attended six or more club meetings and completed their livestock or ham project; FFA members must be members in good standing of a FFA Chapter, under 18 years of age.
5. Only Audrain 4-H and FFA members (age 18 years and under on January 1, 2009) who have completed the particular project (ham, sheep, goat, rabbit, beef, swine or poultry) are eligible to participate.
6. To qualify to sell, steer and market hogs must have been weighed in, all livestock and hams must have been shown at the Audrain County 4-H and Youth Fair.
7. The seller will be required to purchase two photographs, one to be given to the buyer.
8. The seller will refund full purchase price to the buyer should a ham not be edible.
