Who can join?

Clover Kids

Youth ages 5-7 years old are enrolled in the 4-H Clover Kids Program, which is designed to introduce youth to a variety of 4-H experiences.

Community Club

Youth ages 8-18 years old are enrolled in 4-H Community Clubs, where they participate in projects and group opportunities. The clubs elect officers to facilitate meetings where youth experience business, community service, and learning together.

As a new 4-H family, here are the steps you will need to take to be fully enrolled in the program:
