BOER GOATS

1. All animals shown must have been owned by the exhibitor on June 1 or before of the current year.
2. Boer goats shown in the 4-H/FFA class must meet the same health and identification rules as the open show.
3. Exhibitors are limited to two (2) entries per class.
4. The Boer show will be a combined show meaning that 4-H and FFA members will show in the same class.
5. Animals may be hand held or led by a rope and/or halter. Exhibitors are requested to be neatly attired when showing their animals in the ring.
6. Boer goats will be shown Tuesday, July 7, 2009.
7. A BOER GOAT showmanship contest will be held as a part of the goat show.
8. Must be exhibiting Boer Goats to be eligible to participate in this showmanship contest.
