2. Exhibitors must provide their own pens.
3. Poultry, except waterfowl, shown in Missouri shall have originated from Pullorum-Typhoid clean flocks or had a negative test within 90 days of the show. This information must accompany poultry to the show. Birds may be tested day of show.
4. Any bird showing signs of sickness or disease will be removed from the show area.
5. Show will be judged on the Danish system with each bird judged on its own merit.
6. Coop cards will be furnished day of show.
7. **All birds must be pre-entered on entry form. All entries must be postmarked by June 22 or submitted to the Extension Office prior to that date.**
