1. Entries in this division close June 22, 2009. You must pre-enter.
2. Sheep are to arrive Monday evening, July 6, 2009 by 5:00 p.m. for show during the talent show at the Bash.
3. For the 2009 Bates County Fair, a Scrapie ID Tag will be required. Some type of ID number on the animal must match the Health Certificate.
4. Release time will be as soon as the show is over that night.
5. All exhibitors will write in 150 words or less about themselves, what they're wearing and about their ewe. Please have this ready by 5:00 p.m and given to the Superintendents on July 6, 2009. If they are not turned in by 5:30p.m. or have made prior arrangements with the superintendent, they will not be able to participate. Exhibitors must be lined up at the North East corner of the Youth Building with their sheep and ready to enter the ring by 6:00 p.m.
6. All exhibitors must wear wool or wool blend outfits (no more than 30% synthetic), either purchased or constructed by individual.
7. Exhibitor may or may not dress ewe. Sheep must be a breeding class ewe. Purebred/crossbred, fitted for show, halter broke and must be shown in appropriate breeding class.
8. Exhibitors will be judged on the appropriateness and attractiveness of their attire, their poise and appearance and their control and presentation of the ewe.

CLASS NUMBERS:

41. Lead Line (8-10 years of age), Junior
42. Lead Line (11-14 years of age), Intermediate
43. Lead Line (15-19 years of age), Senior
44. Lead Line (6-7 years of age), PeeWee Division

Champions of each division except PeeWee, will receive a trophy, ribbon and 2 yards of Pendleton Wool material.

Reserve Champions will receive ribbons.

PeeWee Division will all receive Green ribbons or participant ribbons.
