**All entries must be postmarked by June 22 or submitted to the Extension Office prior to that date. Health papers will be required.** Open to children ages 5-7 as of January 1, 2009. Animals must be in place by 6:00 p.m. and will be released after the show.

The Pee Wee Show is a noncompetitive event designed to be a fun activity contributing to the growth and development of young people.

Exhibitors are to check in at 6:00 p.m. at the South Cattle Barn as they place their animals. All animals should arrive by 6:00 p.m. and be placed at the northeast corner of the show arena in the south barn. Animals will be released immediately following the show.

Judge(s) will conduct a friendly interview with each exhibitor to determine their knowledge of the animal and its care. Show chairman will determine show order of animals after check-in is complete.

Participation ribbons and/or appropriate prizes will be given to all exhibitors.

Animals may be bucket calves, lambs, goats, miniature horses/ponies not over 46" high at the wither, or any other animal that can be shown on halter, leash, or in a cage. Chairman shall have final say in cases where safety to exhibitors and animals is a concern.

Pee Wee small animals must be entered on the Pee Wee entry form and sent in by June 22, 2009. Each exhibitor may show only one animal.
