

## **Round Robin Showmanship Contest**

**Thursday, July 9, 2009: 1 p.m. or**

**Following the conclusion of the Swine Show  
Contest will be held in the Beef show arena east and  
Hog arena.**

This contest is open to the first and second place in-county divisional showmanship winners of each species of Junior Show (Beef, Sheep, Swine, Horses and Meat Goat).

Each contestant will exhibit their own animal in the first round.

Scoring shall be as follows:

Appearance of animal: 8 points maximum.

Showing and knowledge of animal: 8 points maximum.

Appearance and courtesy of exhibitor: 4 points maximum.

Total points possible: 20

The next three (3) rounds will have each contestant moving to a different species to exhibit the animals there. This scoring shall be as follows:

Appearance of animal: 4 points maximum

Showing and knowledge of animal: 12 points maximum

Appearance and courtesy of exhibitor: 4 points maximum.

Total points possible: 20 per species.

In the event of a tie, the exhibitor scoring highest on their own species will be the winner. (In the event there is still a tie, the chairman will choose another species of their own discretion to determine the winner.)

All contestants of each species will travel together as a group to each respective station. Winners will be announced during the awards ceremony prior to the livestock sale.

Grand Champion Senior Round Robin Showmanship winner is not eligible to compete in the Round Robin contest again in future years. Reserve Champion Senior winner may compete again.

Grand Champion winners of the Intermediate and Junior round Robin Showmanship winners are **not eligible** to compete in the Round Robin contest again until they have reached the next age level.

Reserve Champion winners in the Intermediate and Junior Round Robin may compete in their respective age groups again.
