



# Bates County Junior Rabbit Show Guidelines

Check in: 7:30 a.m.  
Show starts at 8:00 a.m.

### Rules and Regulations

**Under the request of the Fair Board: We ask that all animals stay from the time of check-in until the Jr. Livestock Sale for public viewing. This is mandatory to be able to participate in the Livestock Sale. Out of county participants will be released at the end of the show. Thank you.**

1. **Entry fee: \$2 per head \$6 per pen**
2. Rabbits must be marked in the left ear for identification before check in.
3. Small breeds include any breed with a mature weight of 6 lbs. or less. Large breeds include any breed with a mature weight greater than 6 lbs.
4. **Large breed: Senior rabbits are over 8 months of age; Intermediate rabbits are 6-8 months of age; and Junior rabbits are under 6 months of age. Small breed: Senior rabbits are over 6 months of age and Junior rabbits are under 6 months of age.**
5. EXHIBITORS must place rabbits on the table for judging unless they are committed to another show at the county fair.
6. Only exhibitors showing in that class will be allowed at the judging table.
7. Champion of each breeding stock class will compete for Grand and Reserve Champion of Show.

8. Market Meat will have their own Grand and Reserve. No champion will be named where there is no competition.
9. Judge's decision made at the time of judging is final.
10. Any rabbit entered in the fair may be used for showmanship.
11. All exhibitors are responsible for seeing that their rabbits are fed and watered.
12. Market Meat Pen (Three rabbits, same breed and variety, and minimum 3.5 lbs. and a maximum of 5.5 lbs. to sell.) Meat pen class will be judged after the breed show. 4-H and FFA members are allowed one (1) entry in the meat class. Only blue ribbon meat pens will be allowed to sell through the auction.
13. Single Meat Rabbit (A single meat rabbit weighing a minimum of 3.5 lbs. and a maximum of 5.5 lbs.) Single rabbits will **not** be eligible for the auction. Limit of 2 per exhibitor.
14. Rabbits must have clean appearance at check-in time.
15. **All rabbits must be pre-entered on entry form. All entries must be postmarked by June 17 or submitted to the Fair Board prior to that date.**
