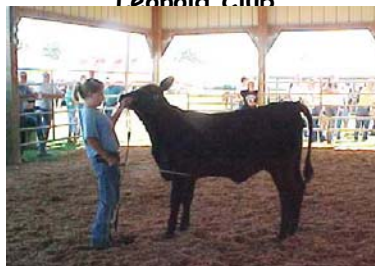

New State Awards
for this fall!!

This year as part of the State 4-H recognition process, youth ages 8-13 will be recognized for their outstanding achievement, leadership, and skill enhancement. Five youth ages 8-10 from each region will be recognized as State Excellence award winners and will receive a certificate and medal of achievement. Three youth ages 11-13 from each region will also be recognized as State Excellence award winners and will receive a scholarship to attend State 4-H Teen Conference.

Youth must complete the Missouri Report Form for their age group. Counties submit forms to regional selection committee. The regional selection committee will forward 5 Missouri 4-H Recognition Worksheets (Level 1 Y2000) for ages 8-10 and 3 Missouri 4-H Recognition Forms (Level 2 Y2100) ages 11-13. These forms are available free of charge from Extension Publications on line at www.extension.missouri.edu/explore/shop or by phone at 1-800-292-0969. 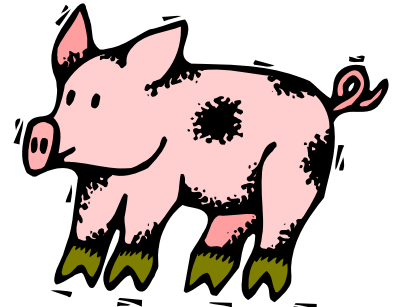
