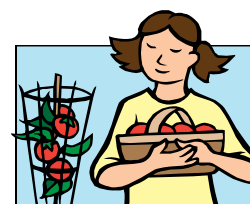

MUST be completed for volunteers to maintain your status with 4-H & can be completed on-line - To log on: Open a web browser, such as Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox

Log on at <http://blackboard.missouri.edu>

Select [Login] - Enter a username of _kids

Enter this password: **volunteer**

- Select [Yes] any time the security information box appears to ask if you want to display non-secure items
- Select link on left side of the screen: [Online 4-H Volunteer Orientation]
- A welcome screen appears to guide through the course

Make sure to go through all the required reading sections, closing remarks and credits and follow the link to required quiz. This link takes the participant to the required, online quiz housed on the SurveyMonkey.com web site. All feedback is confidential & used to improve the volunteer orientation & Missouri 4-H volunteer program.

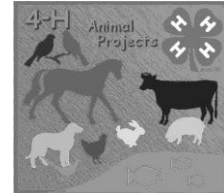

Members – make sure YOU are up to date on this certification by Fair Time! **Missouri Show Me Quality Assurance Certification**



ALL 4-H members enrolled in food animal projects including beef, sheep, swine, dairy cattle, meat & dairy goats, rabbits & poultry **must** complete the appropriate level of MSMQA certification to show & be considered a 4-H member in good standing in that project.

FAIR INFO

**Photography mounting
requirements for 4H
display at the SEMO Fair
are as follows:**

Use 11"x14" mount board. A
permanent mount must be
made using photographic
adhesive - no corner mounts
allowed, no frames allowed.

The mat board may be white,
black, or of a color that
accentuates the photograph.

An entry may be a single photo
on 11"x14" mount board or a
picture story of 4 photographs
on 11"x14" mount board.

Photos can be matted with a
single window mat if
appropriate or a full 11"x14"
photo can be mounted flush on
the mount board.

No double matting.

Posters (14" x 22") are
accepted in ALL
PROJECTS.
