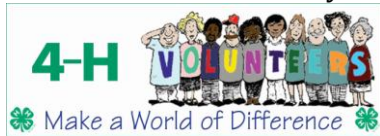

Dress Up Contest

(Poultry, Rabbits, Pigeons, Cavies)

Sunday, Sept. 11 – 12:30 pm

Animals MUST have been shown in 4H or entered to show in open class. Pre-register by noon on the 11th; open to any exhibitor who can control the animal without assistance.

Children's Rooster Crowing & Hen Clucking Contest

Follows Dress Up Contest.

Open to any child under 18; no pre-registration required.

Live Rooster Crowing Contest

Saturday, Sept. 17 – 1:00 pm

1 entry per handler; handler MUST be the exhibitor of the rooster entered in the fair; rooster MUST have participated in open or 4H poultry competition. Pre-register at the Poultry Tent when bringing chickens in.

Livestock Arena Pee Wee Showmanship

Saturday, Sept. 17 – 2:00 pm

Child MUST be 4 and no more than 8 years old as of Dec. 31, 2010. Participant MUST provide a halter broke animal he/she can manage unassisted for the event. Animals already entered in fair competition may be used, or animal may be brought to the grounds before noon on Sept. 17 and removed immediately after event.

Decorate a Bale Contest

Exhibitor must be 18 or under; bale can be prepared by an individual or group. One small bale of hay, straw, grass or bean straw. Entry tags available at Fair Office – must be attached to bale twine. Bales MUST be in place in the Field Crops tent by 6 pm, Sept. 11 and MUST be picked up Sept. 17 between 7 am and 9 pm.

Saturday, September 10

4H Building Exhibit drop off times – 8:00 am to 12:00 Noon; Open Class Arena Bldg./Field Crops drop off times – 8:30 am – 1:00 pm.

You can enter 3 items per project. Posters accepted in all projects – size is 14 x 22 inches (1/2 of a poster board).

Admission to fairgrounds charged starting at 11 a.m.; exhibitors entering between 11 & noon need to show completed entry form to enter at no charge;

Exhibitors wanting to unload at the 4H Hall MUST come in through the Livestock entrance and must be on the grounds before 10:30 a.m.

Exhibit Release Time –
Sunday, September 18,
10:00 am – 12:30 pm.

Make sure your exhibit tag contains ALL the information asked for in the fair book – some projects require info written on the back, some require project leaders signature, etc. Don't lose points on paperwork!!

Release time for livestock – Market Barrows, Steers, Lambs and Goats sold through the sale will be released Sat., Sept. 17 at 11:00 am. All other livestock animals - 6 p.m.
