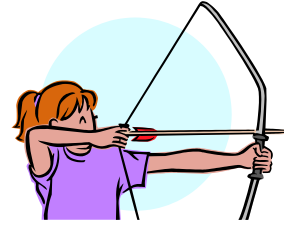


# 4-H Shooting Sports Camp 2011

**When:** Friday, June 10 @ 5 pm to Saturday, June 11 @ 5 pm  
**Where:** Camp Clover Point, Lake of the Ozarks State Park  
**Who:** Youth ages 8 to 18  
**Cost:** \$60 – includes all expenses at camp and for crafts



**What to Bring:** Each camper must bring their own **Ear and Eye Protection**. You will also need:

1) a blanket and sheet (or sleeping bag) and pillow 2) at least one change of clothing for each day at camp, 3) comfortable shoes, 4) at least one pair of long pants, 5) a modest swimsuit, 6) towels, washcloths, soap, toiletries, 7) a flashlight, 8) a jacket or sweater (evenings are often quite cool at the lake in early June).




**SHOES MUST BE CLOSED TOE. NO SANDALS WILL BE ALLOWED.**

Swim shoes (or an old pair of tennis shoes) for the lake front are a good idea.

**DO NOT BRING ANY GUNS, ARCHERY EQUIPMENT OR AMMUNITION.  
(These will be provided.)**

**What NOT To Bring:** Cell phones (any cell phones brought to camp will be locked up for safekeeping and returned at the end of camp), large sums of money (you will not need money at camp), valuable jewelry, radios/jam boxes, fireworks, knives, firearms, clothing with inappropriate advertising, pets, non-medical drugs, alcohol, and tobacco products. Personal radios/cd players are acceptable but should be used with respect for others.

Certified instructors will be present for classes and range work. Each camper will learn responsible and safe use of firearms in the disciplines of Archery, Air pistol, Air rifle, and Hunter skills. (These are the disciplines that are allowed to be offered at Camp Clover Point, which is part of the Lake of the Ozarks State Park.)

-  Offers a 4-H activity that develops firearms safety, responsibility and life skills.
-  Offers an opportunity to become familiarized with different disciplines and try something they might not otherwise try.
-  Offers an opportunity for youth to meet other youth from the Central Region with similar interests in 4-H.

**Clearly label all belongings**—it cannot be guaranteed that you will get items back if they have been left at the Camp.

**You will need to provide your own transportation to the camp** (or possibly arrange a carpool with others from who might be attending.)
