

2011 Boone County Open Breeding Cattle Show

Rules and regulations:

- 1. Rules listed in the general rules section in addition to following rules will apply to the Breeding Cattle Show.**
2. All cattle should be doubled-tied in stall areas with halter and neck rope.
3. Cattle can be tied-out at 8 p.m. Cattle must be tied in by 8 a.m. daily.
4. Unmanageable cattle that cannot be shown in the ring will not be judged or receive a ribbon or be eligible for sale. Nose leads are permissible. The judge or superintendent will make the final decision on cattle that are unmanageable in the ring.
5. No artificial grooming practices, internal or external, will be allowed. Anyone breaking this rule will be disqualified and not allowed to show.
6. Hair- the use of artificial tail fins or the addition of any hair or hair-like substance to the animal's body, excluding a false tail switch, will not be permitted, anyone breaking this rule will be disqualified and not allowed to show.
7. All rule changes for the current show year will be made prior to weigh-in of that season with no rule changes made after that for the current fair year.
8. Exhibitors will be responsible for providing their own bedding in the barn and that there will be no stall fees. Exhibitors will only need to pay for the entries.
9. An exhibitor may enter as many animals as they wish in a single class.

10. A per animal stall fee based upon the chart included below is due with advanced Entry Form to Open Show Superintendent by **Wednesday, June 15, 2011**. Exhibitor must have name, date of birth, and breed of each animal entered. Any substitutions must be approved by the Open Show Superintendent. Stall space will be assigned based upon pre-entries received by **Wednesday, June 15, 2011**. Exhibitor must furnish tie out bedding. **Late entries will be charged an additional late fee of \$10 per entry and will not be guaranteed a stall space.**
11. All cattle must be registered, except for the commercial heifers. The original registration papers of all animals on display must be presented at check-in (duplicates will not be accepted). Registration papers may be called for and must be presented to the Open Show Committee at any time during the fair.
12. The chairpersons will make a show order and class make-up. Any class, which has 10 or more, may be split into two classes. Classes will be split by animal's age.
13. At least two animals, from at least two different owners, must show (total of four (4) animals) within a breed for that breed to qualify for prize money. All others will show in All Other Breeds.
14. All premiums will be pro-rated.
15. All 4-H and FFA members in Missouri are eligible to show in all classes.

BREEDING CATTLE SHOW CLASSES Section B

Instructions for entering Class Numbers on the Animal Entry Form:

Classes will be entered by a two step process:

Step 1: The first part of the class number will use one of the following breed ID's:

BA) Angus

BL) Limousin

BB) Brangus

BM) Maine Anjou

BC) Charolais

BE) Salers

BN) Chianina

BS) Shorthorn

BX) Crossbreed

BT) Simmental

BG) Gelbvieh

BD) All Other Breeds

BH) Hereford

Step 2: The Breed ID is followed by one of the following class numbers:

CLASS Numbers

1. Junior Heifer (born between **January 1, 2010** thru **April 30, 2011**).
2. Senior Yearling Heifer (born between **Sept. 1, 2009** thru **December 31, 2009**).
3. Cow/calf class
4. Junior Bull (born between **January 1, 2010** thru **April 30, 2011**).
5. Senior Yearling Bull (born **between January 1, 2009** thru **December 31, 2009**).
6. Two bulls; any age, and same breed from above classes. Both to be owned by exhibitor.
7. Pair; one bull and one heifer (excludes cows shown in pairs), any age from above classes. Both to be owned by exhibitor.
8. Get of Sire three (3) animals sired by one sire, and from above classes. Both sexes to be represented. All to be owned by exhibitor.

ENTRY EXAMPLE: If I have an Angus Jr. heifer and a Shorthorn bull that I want to show, this is how I would fill out my entry form:
