Boone County 4-H/FFA Rabbit, Poultry and Cavy Show

Location: Small Animal Barn

Entry Time: **Tuesday, July 26**, 6 – 8 pm

Judging: **Poultry: Wednesday, July 27 @ 6 pm**

Rabbit/Cavy: Thursday, July 28 @ 6 pm

Pee Wee Show: Registration at 5:30 pm and show at 5:40 pm day of poultry/rabbit/cavy show. Open to the public, for children ages 4-7 years old. This event is not sponsored by 4-H.

Cage Tag Contest: Maximum size 5" x 7", attach one per cage. Can contain any information such as but not limited to; your name, animal's name, breed, art work, pictures, etc.

Release Time: **Thursday, July 28** following the completion of the rabbit show.

Best of Show and Grand and Reserve Meat Pens will be moved and displayed with other Grand Champion livestock until after the completion of the Livestock Sale.

Rules :

1. Rules listed in the General Rules section in addition to following rules will apply to the Rabbit/Cavy and Poultry Shows.
2. All exhibitors must complete the required Show Me Quality Assurance (SMQA) training for their age in order to be eligible to show.
3. All rabbits, cavies and poultry (**other than meat pen stock**) must be under the daily care and supervision of the project member from **April 14, 2011** to show day. Meat pens of poultry must be under the care and supervision of the project member from **June 7, 2011** to show day. Poultry meat pen birds should 6-8 weeks of age. Poultry and Rabbit meat pens meeting guidelines will be sold at auction. Rabbit meat pens must be the property of the exhibitor by Wednesday, June 15, 2011. **With Entry Form (due June 15), you are required to submit either pedigree of doe (if home raised) or bill of sale for meat pens.** Bill of sale **MUST** include date of purchase, name of seller or rabbitry, address, phone number and signature of person rabbits were purchased from.
4. Rabbits used for the Rabbit Showmanship classes must be under the care and supervision of the project member from **April 14, 2011** to show day.

5. All exhibitors must be members in good standing of a 4-H/FFA Rabbit or Poultry project to be shown and entries must be turned in by **Wednesday, June 15, 2011** to the Extension Office. **No entries will be accepted after this date.** Each exhibitor is allowed two substitutions out-of-breed, with no limit to in-class substitutions. **All substitutions must be made directly to the respective small animal superintendent. No substitutions are allowed after 12:00 noon, Thursday, July 7, 2011.**
6. All animals must be entered, exhibited, handled and shown by the project member **unless specific arrangements have been made with the respective small animal superintendent.**
7. Exhibitors must provide their own water and food dishes.
8. Exhibitors must provide adequate wire cages for their rabbits, cavy or poultry for the three day stay.
9. Rabbits or cavy are not required to have ear tattoos.
10. All exhibited animals must be free of any visible signs of infection, contagious disease or parasites. Exhibitors may be asked to remove any project animal not in good health. Dismissal will be at the discretion of the Small Animal Superintendent or Judge.
11. Due to possible omissions or mistakes in printing of the rules, the Small Animal Committee reserves the right to final interpretation of the rules and will make any final decision concerning the Small Animal Poultry or Rabbit/Cavy Shows.
12. Each exhibitor is required to sign up for a time to watch the small animal barn during their stay.
13. **All birds will have to pass the blood test on Tuesday, July 26 at the 6 pm – 8 pm check-in.**

POULTRY SHOW CLASSES Section P

Instructions for entering Class Numbers on the Animal Entry Form: Classes will be identified by one of the following:

P01 Large Breed Single Cock	6	4	2

Chicken Meat Pen:

- The poultry must be a broiler type bird.
- There must be three birds in this pen. All three birds must be of the same breed.
- The birds should be 6-8 weeks old.

RABBIT/CAVY SHOW CLASSES Section R/C

- Rabbit/Cavy will be judged by Breed and only shown in one class (pet or breed not both)
- Five or more in a breed, best of breed trophy other wise best of breed ribbon
- From all Best of Breed Rabbit/Cavy, second reserve, first reserve & best in show will be selected

Instructions for entering Class Numbers on the Animal Entry Form: Classes will be entered by a two step process:

Step 1: The first part of the class number will use one of the following breed ID's:

Step 2: The Breed ID is followed by one of the following class numbers:

<u>CLASS Numbers – Rabbits</u>	<u>CLASS NUMBERS - Cavies</u>
1 Small Breed Bucks	1 Boars
2 Small Breed Does	2 Sows
3 Large Breed Bucks	
4 Large Breed Does	

The Following classes do not need a breed ID code:

R5	Meat Pen
R6	Pet Class

Rabbit Meat Pen:

- The rabbits must be meat breeds, such as California, New Zealand etc.
- There must be three rabbits in a pen. All three rabbits must be of the same breed.
- No more than two meat pens per exhibitor.
- No more than 5 lbs. each in weight and no more than 10 weeks old

ENTRY EXAMPLE: If I have a Polish Buck, a Mini Rex Doe and a meat pen that I want to show, this is how I would fill out my entry form:
