To participate in the County and State Fair competitions, you must be a member in good standing. You need to have attended 50% of your club meetings and done a demonstration.

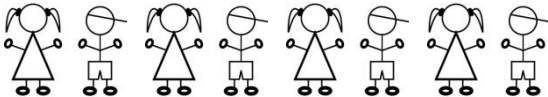

Please contact Pam at the Extension Office if you are interested in this contest. There will be an information packet available telling you the details of this event.



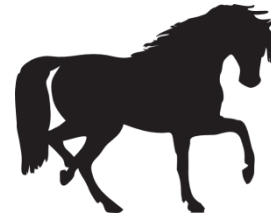
FULTON STREET FAIR KIDDIE

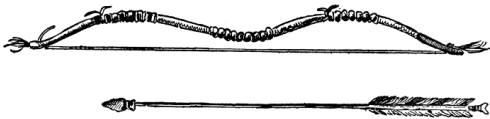
All events will be held at the Rough Riders Arena on Route H with check-in starting at 5:00pm and the events starting at 6:00pm.

MISS & JR MISS CALLAWAY COUNTY FAIR QUEEN PAGEANT

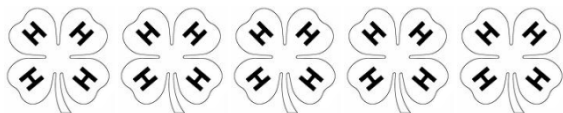
