Rules & Regulations

1. All dogs must check-in at 6:30 p.m. on Friday, August 7 in the Livestock Show Arena.
2. The Dog Show will begin at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, August 7 in the Livestock Show Arena.
3. See health regulations that apply to your animals in the "Animal Health Requirements" section of this book.
4. All Dogs must be current on their vaccinations. Dogs 4 months and older must have a current rabies vaccination. A current rabies dog tag or certification from a veterinarian is required at registration to be able to show. NO EXCEPTIONS!
5. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.
6. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.
7. Entry fees will be \$2.00 per head.
8. Grand Champions and Reserve Champions will receive a rosette and an award. Costume and Trick winners will receive an award. Showmanship winners will receive a T-shirt.
9. Ribbons will be awarded to all participants using the Danish systems (blue, red, white).
10. *Points for the dog show are 10-8-6.*
11. Total premium points earned will be divided into a block of money to determine exact premium money paid. Premiums will be disbursed approximately thirty (30) days after the completion of the fair.
12. Superintendent's and Judge's decisions are final.

Costume

Dog and trainer both dress in costume.
Junior Division: 8-11 years, Senior Division: 12 years & older

Tricks

Tricks are limited to a total of 3 tricks. Exhibitor must announce what the trick is prior to performance. Participant is allowed 3 tries for each trick – if the dog does not perform the trick after 3 tries, you must move on to your next trick. You cannot go back and retry any trick that you have already attempted with 3 tries.
