Rules & Regulations

1. All market rabbits must check-in and weigh-in at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 4 in the east end of Cattle Barn.
2. The Market Rabbit Show will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 4 in the east end of the Cattle Barn.
3. All market rabbits will be released following the Market Rabbit Show, except market rabbits being sold which will need to return by Wednesday, August 5 at 5:00 p.m. for the Youth Livestock Sale. Fair Personnel and Superintendent are not responsible for the care of market rabbits between show date and auction.
4. There will be a **MANDATORY** market rabbit exhibitor meeting to be announced by the Superintendent.
5. See health regulations that apply to your animals in the "Animal Health Requirements" section of this book.
6. Rabbits to be exhibited must be free of any clinical signs of infection or contagious disease.
7. Exhibitors are limited to 2 entries per class, including 2 market pens of 3 rabbits.
8. Market rabbits must be in exhibitor's possession 30 days prior to opening date of fair.
9. Market rabbits must be under 10 weeks of age.
10. No tattoo required. Do use permanent marker to put an ID number in the left ear of each rabbit.
11. If no pre-entries are received by July 26, 2009, there will be no Market Rabbit Show. Pre-entries need to be sent to Marsha Cave at 225 East Simon, Holts Summit, MO 65043 or marshacody@embarq.com.
12. See sale requirements in the "Youth Livestock & Ham Sales Rules & Regulations" section of this book.
13. Entry fee will be \$2.00 per class.
14. Ribbons will be awarded to all participants using the Danish systems (blue, red, white).
 1. *Points for the market rabbits are 10-6-2.*
Total premium points earned will be divided into a block of money to determine exact premium money paid. **Premiums** will be disbursed *approximately thirty (30) days after the completion of the fair.*
 2. Grand Champion and Res. Champion will receive a rosette and an award.
 3. Superintendent's and Judge's decisions are final.

Rules & Regulations

1. All breeding rabbits must check-in at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 6 in the Livestock Show Arena.
2. The Breeding Rabbit Show will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 6 in the Livestock Show Arena.
3. All breeding rabbits will be released following the Breeding Rabbit Show.
4. See health regulations that apply to your animals in the “Animal Health Requirements” section of this book.
5. Rabbits to be exhibited must be free of any clinical signs of infection or contagious disease.
6. Exhibitors are limited to 2 entries per class, including 2 market pens of 3 rabbits.
7. Breeding rabbits must be in exhibitor’s possession by April 1, 2009.
8. The litter must be no younger than 4 weeks or age, or older than 6 weeks. The Doe and Litter must be kept together.
9. All rabbits 6 weeks old and older shall be tattooed in the left ear.
10. Breeding Rabbits will show in their individual breed classes first. Best of breed winners will then show in their respective age classes.
11. Pre-entries are used to save on time and have an estimate of the number of participants. Pre-entries need to be sent to Marsha Cave at 225 East Simon, Holts Summit, MO 65043 or marshancody@embarq.com.
12. Entry fee will be \$2.00 per class.
13. Ribbons will be awarded to all participants using the Danish systems (blue, red, white).
14. *Points for the breeding rabbits are 10-6-2.*
Total premium points earned will be divided into a block of money to determine exact premium money paid.
Premiums will be disbursed approximately thirty (30) days after the completion of the fair.
15. Champions and Champion Opposites will receive a rosette. Supreme Champion and Supreme Champion Opposite will receive a rosette and an award. Showmanship winners will receive a T-shirt.
16. Superintendent’s and Judge’s decisions are final.
