### Guidelines

1. The calf can be any breed (beef or dairy) born between February 15 – May 1, 2009. Bull calves must have been castrated 30 days prior to show. Heifers four (4) months of age should be calfhood vaccinated for brucellosis.
2. The Bobby Calf Project Leader is required to see the calf within ten (10) days of purchase. The young person (buyer) is responsible for contacting the project leader as soon as he/she has purchased the animal.
3. The calf must be have been hand fed since the time it was two weeks if age (cannot be nursing a cow).
4. Bobby calves are not eligible to be sold at the fair auction, nor shown in any breeding classes.
5. The criteria for judging at the fair will be based on:
  - ❖ 30% Showmanship
  - ❖ 40% Condition and Health of Animal
  - ❖ 30% Knowledge about the animal (i.e. breed, age, feeding practices, etc.).
6. Participants may show only one bobby calf. They may raise more than one bobby calf.
7. If a young person shows a bobby calf, he/she is not allowed to show in the beef show (market beef or breeding stock).

8. Show sticks are optional.
9. Classes will be divided at the livestock show according to age and experience of the young person (not breed, age, sex, etc. of the animal).

Class Number	Exhibitor Age	Exhibitor Experience
500A	5 – 7	Clover kid class, participation ribbon, no stall fee or premium payback.
500B	8 – 11	First time showing/first year in 4-H
500C	8 - 11	Second time and over exhibitors

10. Exhibitors should have calf in place and be ready to be interviewed by judge at 8:30 a.m. Each exhibitor will visit the judge in a one-on-one interview and is encouraged to bring records, pictures, etc. to show the judge.
