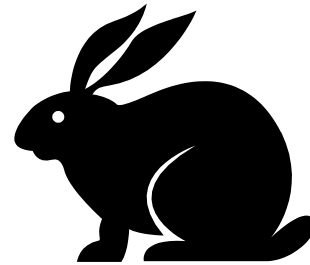

1. The show will be governed by the latest rules of the ARBA and your entry indicates acceptance of ARBA rules and the rules listed below.
2. All rabbits will be judged according to the latest ARBA standards.
3. Purebred Rabbits:
 - a. All purebred rabbits will be entered by breed according to sex and age divisions.
 - b. Four-class rabbits will be judged by Bucks and Does, Jr. (under 6 months of age) and Sr. (over 6 months of age).
 - c. Six-class rabbits will be judged by Buck and Doe; Pre-Juniors/Juniors (under 6 months of age), 6-8 rabbits (6-8 months old), and Senior (over 8 months of age).
 - d. All Best of Breed winners entered will compete for Best of Show and Reserve Best of Show.
4. Crossbred and Mixed Breed Rabbits:
 - a. Will be entered and judged separate from purebred rabbits.
 - b. Rabbits will be separated into categories by breed that most closely applies to that animal. Each category will be divided by sex and age.
 - c. Classes will be judged by the standard that most closely applies to that category.
 - d. Each category winner will compete for Best of Show/Reserve Best of Show.
5. Exhibitors entering the day of the show will be responsible for filling out their own comment cards and entry sheets.
6. Rabbits and cavy must be permanently and legibly earmarked.
7. All animals showing signs of disease will be removed from the showroom and entry fee forfeited.
8. The association reserves the right to substitute judges and to secure the service of additional judges if required.
9. This will be a carrier show only. No cooping is available. Please have pan on all carriers.
10. All awards and comment card must be picked up at the time of the show. Ribbons will be awards for blue, red, and white placing for all classes.
11. All breeding rabbits must be owned by the exhibitor and in their possession on or before June 1, 2009.



Rabbit (cont.)

MEAT PEN CLASSES

1. All meat pens rabbits consist of 3 rabbits of same breed and variety. Sire and dam must be owned by June 1, 2009.
2. Rabbits must not weigh more than 5 lbs. each.
3. The Champion and Reserve Champion Meat Pens must sell in the Cass County Junior Livestock Auction.
4. Disqualified meat pens will not be eligible for sale in the auction.
