

CEDAR COUNTY 4-H ROYALTY SELECTION

1. Each club is invited to elect/select up to six candidates to represent the club at the county royalty contest at Share the Fun Night.
Each club leader should obtain appropriate entry forms for each age group.
2. **The purpose of this event is to recognize participation and achievement by each 4-H member selected by his/her club, AND to recognize outstanding members as 4-H County Ambassadors.**
3. All club members who meet the requirements as stated and want to participate should complete a score sheet and submit it to the county office by deadline.
4. Members must be currently enrolled in the 4-H club and must have paid club, county, and state dues.
5. Members must have attended a majority of club meetings up to the date of the interviews and event and be a member in good standing.
6. **Age Requirements**

King or Queen	Age 14 to 18 by January 1
Prince or Princess	Age 11 to 13 by January 1
Jr. Prince or Jr. Princess	Age 8 to 10 by January 1
7. The club should vote on which members will represent the club, or the club could select the highest scoring candidates as this year's representatives.
8. Winners from previous years are not eligible in the same age category.
9. Clubs may determine if previous CANDIDATES are eligible to run again in the same age group.
10. All royalty applications must be received in the county office before the deadline.
11. All royalty candidates will be required to attend an interview.
12. Do not add additional pages. Photos are not required.
13. All entries must attend the interview and be present at coronation to be eligible for Royalty honors.
14. Judging is on a point system. 10 points - Appearance, 10 points - Poise, 10 points - Personality, 10 points - Community Service, 10 Points - School Related Participation, plus total on Score Sheet.
15. Dress for interview and Coronation - Girls should wear a suit or dress. Boys should wear dress pants, shirt, and tie.
