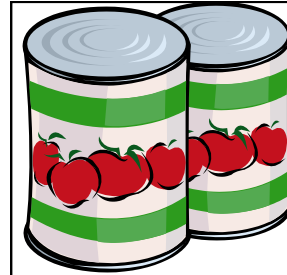

## How To Get To “Bright and Bold XV” at Neosho, January 24

**Neosho Middle School, 1400 Hale McGinty Drive, Neosho 64850**

**From the North – While traveling South on Hwy 71**, take Exit 11 (to Hwy 60E; turn Left onto Kodiak Rd.; at the stop sign (Waldo Hatler Dr.) turn Right; turn Right onto Hale McGinty

**From the East – While traveling West on Hwy 60**, continue past the Neosho Wal-Mart; turn Right onto Kodiak Rd.; the stop sign (Waldo Hatler Dr.) turn Right; turn Right onto Hale McGinty

**From the South – While traveling North on Hwy 71**, take Exit 11 (to Hwy 60E; turn Left onto Kodiak Rd.; at the stop sign (Waldo Hatler Dr.) turn Right; turn Right onto Hale McGinty



## How to get to “Making the Best Better IX” at Mt. Vernon; January 17

Mt. Vernon Middle School, 731 S. Landrum Street, Mt. Vernon

**From the North – While traveling South on Hwy 39**, turn left on Sloan Street (at the football field. The school is on your left.

**From the South – While traveling North on Hwy 39**, turn right on Sloan Street (at the football field). The school is on your left.

**From the East—**While traveling West on I-44, take Exit 46 (highway 39). At the top of the off ramp, turn right onto the business loop. Turn right (north) on Highway 39. Turn right on Sloan Street (at the football field. The school is on your left.

**From the West—**While traveling East on I-44, take Exit 44 (highway H). At the bottom of the off ramp, turn left. Turn left (north) on Highway 39. Turn right on Sloan Street (at the football field. The school is on your left.
