Missouri Youth Livestock Grading & Judging Workshop

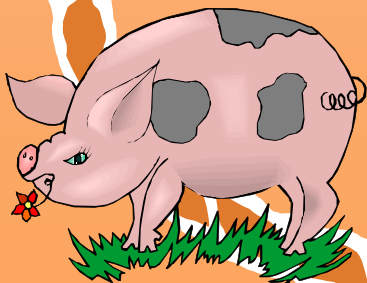
ACTIVITIES

4. This event will be an individual competition for youth only with emphasis on education.
5. Plaques will be awarded to the top 5 ranking youth individuals participating in all activities of the workshop.
6. Contestants must be registered by February 13, 2009 and submit a registration fee of \$6.00 per person (no refunds)
7. Tabulation of results will be completed by 5:00 p.m. Thursday, March 19, 2009.
