## KC Global Summit

4-H members 15 and up are eligible to attend the KC Global Summit March 14-17, 2012 in Kansas City. The Summit provides opportunities for youth to explore careers, technology, environment and cultural diversity in a global society.



Program features :

- Tours to Kansas City area businesses and organizations (like Bayer Science, Lee Jeans, Board of Trade, Federal Reserve, Smith Electric Vehicles and Farmland Foods)
- Workshops showcasing a variety of careers (like engineering, international law, CSI, archeology, DJ Audio, nuclear pharmacy, veterinary medicine and law enforcement.
- Cultural events like an ethnic enrichment festival including food, music and art.
- Dances and other group events that allow you to meet other youth from Arkansas, Kansas, Oklahoma and Missouri.

The cost is \$275 per delegate.

Registration forms and payment are due to the Extension Office by December 9th.



## SMQA

Show-Me Quality Assurance (SMQA) training is required by all 4-H and FFA members to exhibit food animal at the county fair. Those under 13 must complete 2 consecutive years of training to be conditionally certified. An additional year of training is also required once youth reach 14.
