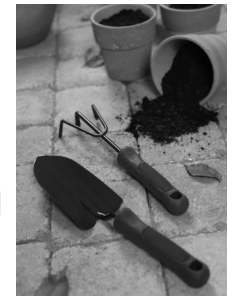
Spring Gardening Seminar
