Above you will find the work schedule for the 2018 fair. The air conditioning in the food stand allows us more efficient work space. It allows us to have fewer workers so we can have shorter work shifts. 10 to 12 members with parents can handle a two hour shift. Night shifts may require a few more. Parents and members, it will be important to be there at your assigned time. We can not operate properly without your help. As in the past, there is an overlap of shifts to allow for smoother transition. **It is important due to health issues that you wear a hat or visor, or a hair net will be provided.** Gloves are also required when working with items that will be served to the public. The Cooper County Public Health Office will be monitoring the Food Stand during the fair. These are county requirements for your safety and for the safety of our patrons. You will note that the shift time frame also mentions a cashier for each time period. Leaders may assign others to help. Members should be aware that an adult will be taking care of the money, thereby helping younger members. During slow serving times, members can clean tables, counters and pick up trash outside the stand.

All members and parent workers should sign in at the beginning of their shift. Signing in does **not** mean you have worked. Please stay and do your part. Working together makes the time go quicker for all. All members who work their full shift will be able to take credit on their records. Participation at clean up days and the food stand will determine point money eligibility.

We must request that you do not eat in the Food Stand during your shift. There will not be room and health issues prohibit it. At the end of a full shift worked, club leaders or food stand manager will allow members to receive a free tea or lemonade drink and a sandwich of their choice at ½ price. All soda and Gatorade products will be cash sales.

Cleaning of the food stand will be held in conjunction with clean up days.

If you are a member of 4-H and FFA, you and a parent/adult will need to work during both organizations established times. THANK YOU for all of your help and cooperation. The food stand is one part of making our fair a success.
