Camp Counselors are a very important part of 4-H Camp. They work with youth ages 8 to 13 and assist the camp staff. In addition, the counselor experience provides an opportunity to make new friendships and lifetime memories, while learning valuable leadership skills. Those interested in being selected to be camp counselors this summer will need to attend three training sessions in Rolla: Tuesday, March 12; Monday, April 1; Monday, April 22 and also Counselor Camp Friday May 31 – Saturday June 1 at Camp Clover Point - Lake of the Ozark State Park.

If accepted as a counselor, you will be responsible for the 4-H Counselor Camp fee (\$60). The Crawford County 4-H Council will pay your regular 4-H Camp fee (\$130).

The application must be completed and returned by March 4, 2019.
