### LIVESTOCK SHOW RULES

**Eligibility**  
All livestock departments open to any youth living in Missouri. See each department for age requirements. Active FFA members may also show through age 21. "Pee Wee" classes are included in most departments.

**Entry forms**  
Entry forms are available day of fair

**Entry Fees**  
Entry fees are \$3 per head, except in rabbit and poultry departments, where fee is \$3 per exhibitor, per 1 to 5 entries. Late fees are accepted at the discretion of the department chairmen. Make checks payable to the Dallas County Fair.

**General rules**

- Each exhibitor must own his or her animal during the fair, with no change of ownership within 30 days prior. Department chairmen may require proof of ownership. Show animals need not be registered. Judges may challenge entry ages at their discretion.
- The superintendent may permit another Missouri junior exhibitor to show an animal in cases of illness or physical handicap. In cases where an exhibitor has more than one animal in a class, another Missouri junior exhibitor must show the second animal.
- Animals must be in place by specified times prior to shows. Animals will not be released until the show is over. Failure to comply with these rules could cost exhibitors premiums.
- All Missouri state health requirements will be strictly enforced. **HEALTH PAPERS WILL BE CHECKED FOR ALL LIVESTOCK EXCEPT RABBITS, HOGS, WATERFOWL AND CATTLE.**
  - a) Sheep, goats: identification of animal must be on health paper AND animal (except wethers) must have official ID or tattoo to identify flock of origin.
  - b) Horses: only negative Coggins required.
  - c) Poultry (excludes waterfowl): VS Form 9-2 or similar certificate showing negative Pullorum-Typhoid test certificate available on site. Poultry will be tested free of charge by MDA at 2 p.m. day of show.

5. Classes may be adjusted the day of the show, based on number of entries.  
6. Disputes will be settled by chair of individual show, in consultation with concerned exhibitors.  
7. All exhibitor premium checks MUST be cashed in 90 days or they will be voided.

**Premiums**  
All classes will be judged on the Danish system. Premiums will be based on point values, to be determined after the fair based on the availability of premium funds. A maximum of 150 points will be paid to any exhibitor in a livestock division. **An exhibitor may collect no more than five premiums in a single livestock department.**

**Herdsmen awards**  
A herdsman award will be given an exhibitor in some livestock departments. Judging will be based on: (1) cleanliness and appearance of animals at all times; (2) cooperation with others in the exhibit area; (3) attitude, neatness and courtesy of the exhibitor while attending livestock.
