Thanksgiving Centerpiece-

Ingredients

- Glue gun and glue sticks
- a plate
- feathers
- fake leaves
- 2 pine cones
- 4 googly eyes
- 2 foam pumpkins
- 4 orange pipe cleaners
- Letter stickers

Instructions

1. Add the personalized name to the plate with letter stickers.
2. Attach leaves on the bottom of the plate with hot glue.
3. Attach googly eyes to the flat side of the pine cone and feathers to the other end with hot glue.
4. Cut the pipe cleaner and fold in half to create a beak. Attach with hot glue.



5. Cut two more sections of pipe cleaner and fold to create feet. Glue to the bottom of the pinecone.
6. Attach 'pine cone' turkeys to the plate and add additional fall themed decorations to complete the look!
7. Place on the center of table to add an extra special flare for your Thanksgiving!
