Completing a Year of 4-H Membership-

4-H club members will be recognized for setting & completing goals for the year. To successfully complete the year & receive recognition, a 4-H member should:

- * Attend a majority of club meetings
- * Enroll in and complete at least one project
- * Demonstrate a skill learned or knowledge gained by making a handmade item, exhibiting a project, or presenting a speech, report or demonstration in a group setting.

Supplies:

- sucker sticks
- Serving Tray
- Bag of Mini Marshmallows
- Kraft Caramels

Directions

- 1) Push each end of the sucker sticks into a marshmallow.
