

# 2009 NEW HAVEN COMMUNITY YOUTH FAIR ~ NEW HAVEN, MISSOURI

## GENERAL RULES FOR LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS

1. **All exhibitors must be pre-registered. All food animal exhibitors need to have completed the Show Me Quality Assurance to be eligible to show.** All advance registrations must be mailed by July 1, 2009 to:

2. Rabbits, Poultry, Sheep and Goats must be in place by the designated time on the day of the show. They will be released between 7:30 and 10:00 p.m. on the evening of the show. The exact time will be determined by the Livestock Committee and announced that evening.  
  
Swine, Beef, and Dairy Cattle must be in place by the designated time on the day of the show. They will be released as soon as possible after the show, with the exact time to be determined by the Livestock Committee.  
  
Stall area must be cleaned before animals are removed from the fair grounds. **Premiums will be forfeited if exhibits are removed before the release time, or if stall area is not cleaned. Any animal deemed unmanageable by the Livestock Committee before, during, or after the show will be required to leave the grounds.**
3. Read health requirements.
4. The New Haven Youth Fair Livestock shows are open to anyone up to 18 years old.
5. Animals exhibited must be owned and shown by the exhibitor. If an exhibitor has more than one exhibit in a class, the exhibitor may recruit another youth exhibitor to show one of the animals.
6. Bedding for livestock must be provided by the exhibitor.
7. Judging will be based on the Danish System; all exhibits will receive a blue, red, or white ribbon. Prize money will be awarded based on the ribbon received. (Dollar value of ribbons will be determined by the New Haven Fair Board.)
8. Livestock exhibitors must use Livestock Entry Form.
9. Exhibitors will be limited to two entries per single animal class and one entry per group class.  
  
10. A stall fee of \$2.00 per animal for beef and dairy, \$1.00 per animal for sheep, swine, and goats and 50 cents per entry for rabbits and poultry must accompany advanced registration. Doe and litter and pen classes will be considered as one entry. Stall fee may be paid in cash or check.  
**Checks are payable to the New Haven Youth Fair.**
12. No trophy will be given unless there are two or more animals within a breed.
13. Showmanship trophies will be awarded in the age divisions below for Beef, Swine, Sheep, Goat, Poultry, and Rabbits. Contestants must exhibit animals on their own.
  - a. Youth Showmanship - Contestants must exhibit animals on their own. - Up to 10 years.
  - b. Intermediate Showmanship - Contestants age 11-14 years as of Jan. 1, 2008.
  - c. Senior Showmanship - Contestants 15 to 18 years of age as of Jan. 1, 2008.
  - d. Must be 2 exhibitors before trophy is awarded.
  - e. Exhibitors will be judged throughout the Beef show. Exhibitors will be required to wear numbers provided by the Livestock Committee.

## ANIMAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR EXHIBITION - 2009

### HEALTH CERTIFICATES / GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- A. All animals must have a health certificate unless specifically exempted. The health certificate must show required tests, vaccinations, etc., and individual identification and description of animals. Health certificates are valid for thirty (30) days.
- B. Animals with ringworm lesions or easily visible warts will not exhibit and will have to be removed from community holding areas and stalls since these are contagious conditions.
- C. The following listed entry requirements on livestock are for exhibition only. These minimal health and testing requirements do not qualify livestock that are to be sold or moved to a new owner or destination. Please investigate and comply with the added requirements for livestock that are to be in a sale as well as in an exhibition.

### EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS FOR CATTLE IN THE STATE OF MISSOURI

- A. Intrastate (cattle in Missouri moving for exhibition only in Missouri, no health certificate required).
  1. Brucellosis: No test or vaccination is required.
  2. Tuberculosis: Tuberculosis tests are not required in Missouri cattle.
  3. Scabies (mangs): Cattle originating in scabies-quarantined areas or herds are not eligible to exhibit.

### BUCKET CALF CLASS

Class 14

1. Exhibitors may be no older than 12 as of January 1, 2009
2. Classes will be determined by age groups.
3. The calf may be dairy, beef or cross, heifer, steer or bull.
4. The class is limited to one calf per exhibitor.
5. Calf must be born between January 1, 2009 and April 1, 2009.
6. Entries must be shown at halter.
7. Each class winner will be shown for grand and reserve champions.
8. The class will be judged on the following criteria:
 

25 points	Presentation of the calf in the show ring
20 points	Condition and health of the calf
5 points	Quality of the calf
50 points	Judge's interview to assess the member's knowledge of the calf, feeding and care of the calf.

Intrastate (Swine in Missouri moving for exhibition only in Missouri) - No certificate of veterinary inspection is required.

- 1 BRUCELLOSIS: No test is required
2. PSEUDORABIES No test is required

**EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS FOR POULTRY**

- A. Poultry must have no signs of contagious or infectious disease. Poultry must have a VS Form 9-2 (or similar certificate) showing a negative Pullorum - Typhoid test within the past ninety (90) days to exhibition or originate from a flock approved by the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP). Waterfowl are exempt from this testing requirement. A representative of the department shall have access to the event and may inspect or test poultry as considered necessary.
- B. Sponsors of any poultry exhibition must notify the state veterinarian at least thirty (30) days prior to the exhibition with names, places, dates and times of the event. The sponsor shall keep records for one (1) year, including owner information, species, breed, type and pullorum-typhoid status of poultry exhibited.

Poultry exhibits are to be pre-registered on livestock entry form. Limit one exhibit for pen class and two exhibits for other classes. An exhibitor may enter a total of 20 exhibits in the Poultry Show.

**EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS FOR RABBITS**

Rabbit entries are to be pre-registered on livestock entry form. Limit one exhibit in Doe and Litter and Pen classes, and two exhibits in other classes. Members exhibiting in the Pet class are limited to two exhibits in the class, and no more than four exhibits for the show. All other exhibitors are limited to 16 exhibits for the show. Rabbits shown in the Pet class may not be shown in any other class. Rabbits shown in the Market Pen class may not be shown in classes 85-94. Rabbits shown in the Doe and Litter class may not be exhibited in any other class. Rabbits must be placed one hour before show time. Exhibitors must arrange to have cages at least six inches off the ground.

**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR POULTRY AND RABBITS**

- A. All rabbits and birds must be totally free of disease or parasites. Animals exhibiting parasites or disease will not be placed in the tent, and will be disqualified from the show.
  - 1. Animals will be checked for visible signs of parasites and disease before they are unloaded from the exhibitor's vehicle.

**EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS FOR GOATS**

- A. Intrastate (goats in Missouri exhibited in Missouri)
  - 1. Goats that are to be exhibited must be free of clinical signs infectious or contagious disease.
  - 2. Goats (except castrated males) must be identified to flock of origin using official ID(ear tags or tattoos) and listed on a health certificate.

**EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS FOR SHEEP**

- A. Intrastate (sheep in Missouri exhibited in Missouri)
  - 1. Sheep that are to be exhibited must be free of clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease.
  - 2. Sheep (except castrated males) must be identified to flock of origin using official ID(ear tags or tattoos) and listed on a health certificate.
  - 3. Scabies
    - a. Sheep from a scabies quarantined area must be dipped or treated by an officially approved method within ten (10) days prior to exhibition.
    - b. A prior permit number must be obtained and recorded on a health certificate if the sheep are from a scabies quarantined area.
