

Franklin County Cattlemen's Post High School Scholarship Application

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must have been a full-time college student or full-time student in a technical program the previous year and not have reached their 23rd birthday by January 2018 and be enrolled as a full time student for the fall semester of 2017. Applicant must be enrolled in a four-year college degree, a two-year associate degree, or an intensive technical program. Applicant and/or applicant's parents or grandparents must be residents of Franklin County, current members of the Missouri Cattlemen's Association and/or actively participating in Franklin County Cattlemen's Association activities and promotion for two years prior to the application deadline.

This scholarship will be awarded based on the applicants' involvement in Franklin County Cattlemen activities, interest in agriculture and the beef industry, academic performance, leadership, citizenship, need and career plans.

Recipients will be asked to assist with one of the Franklin County Cattlemen's Beef Promotion activities in 2017.
