Steers: Steers will be placed in classes according to breed and weight. There will be NO re-weighs. Weigh in will take place from 9am - 11am the day of show Steers must have been born in 2010.

We reserve the right to mouth any steer. Steers must have their baby teeth. In order to show as a breed, steers must have registration papers or they will be shown as crossbred

Heifers: Heifers must have been born between: 9/1/09 - 1/1/11 Heifers must have registration papers, or it will be shown in the crossbred class Heifers will be shown from youngest to oldest.

Any and all animals may be subject to veterinary examination.

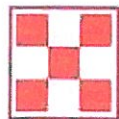
All cattle are released after their respective show.
