RULES:

1. Posters must be 14" X 22" (half a sheet of poster board).
2. Coloring tools such as crayons, markers, or paints may be used for your poster. Glitter markers and puff paints are also allowed.
3. Posters may **not** include cutouts or glued items.
4. Tracing or use of stencils is not allowed.
5. No three-dimensional objects may be attached to the poster.
6. Please print name, address, 4-H Club, and age as of December 31, 2016, neatly in pencil or ink on the upper right hand corner of the **back** of the poster.
7. Posters must be brought to the Franklin County Extension Center by 4:30 p.m., Friday, March 24.

Poster Art Judging will be based on:

A: Information given and Idea Expressed: 50 points

1. Use of theme.....20
2. Simplicity..... 10
3. Originality 10
4. Reflection of age & ability 10

B: Art, Design, Lettering: 50 points

1. Pleasing, attractiveness, composition20
2. Dynamic, eye catching, original 10
3. Neat, easily read lettering 10
4. Use of color..... 10
