1. Exhibitors must be at least 8 years old as of January 1, 2009.
2. Exhibitors must be enrolled in a Poultry project in 4-H, FFA or an APA/ABA Youth Program and be a member in good standing.
3. All poultry must be owned by exhibitor on or before June 1, 2009.
4. All poultry must be on the grounds and checked in through the Superintendents by 10:00 a.m. on Friday, July 31, 2009.
5. All poultry will be released at 8:00 p.m. on Friday, July 31, 2009.
6. All poultry must be pre-registered before July 6, 2009 at the Extension Center using the Livestock Exhibit Registration Form.
7. Entry fee of \$1.00 /head per class must accompany the registration form.
8. The show is open to counties surrounding Gasconade County.
9. The Danish System of judging will be used to place the animals. Exhibitors will receive Blue, Red or White ribbons. Premiums will be paid according to a point system of 6-4-2.
10. Each exhibitor needs to have each cage labeled with: NAME, CLUB and TYPE of poultry.
11. Each Exhibitor must provide adequate cage, space, water, shade and care of the animal(s).
12. All birds must have a negative Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days of exhibition OR come from a NPIP Flock.
13. Cocks and Hens hatched prior to Jan. 1, 2009. Cockerels and Pullets hatched since Jan. 1, 2009.
