## **RULES AND INFORMATION**

Class number for Steer is Class #16

1. Sale will be held at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday at the fair.
2. All steers to be sold must be weighed and identified at weigh-in date scheduled by the livestock committee. This information must be recorded at the Gasconade County Extension Office.
3. Steers must be dehorned and castrated at time of tagging.
4. Steers must be owned by the exhibitor and must be carried as a project either in 4-H or Agricultural Education. It at all possible, steers must be fed on exhibitor's premises.
5. Must be tied in stall with rope halter and neck rope.
6. Records on the steer are to be presented by the exhibitor when called for by the committee. To be eligible to show and sell a steer, the exhibitor must live in Gasconade County or be a member of a 4-H Club or FFA Chapter within Gasconade County.
7. A 4-H or FFA Member may weigh and identify two steers but only one steer can be exhibited in the steer show and sale.
8. Steers will be weighed when arriving at the fair and this weight will be posted above the steer in his stall and used as selling weight. **Steers must weigh at least 1000 lbs. at Fair.**
9. Sale order - sell according to placing.
10. Steers will be placed by judge who judges the other beef classes at the fair.
11. Entry fee is \$7.50 to be submitted with entry form.
12. A rate of gain class will be included.
13. Selling fee is \$10.00 per head.
14. There will be a Steer Showmanship Class following the Steer Show. If you show in Steer Showmanship, you cannot show in the Breeding Cattle Showmanship Class.
15. There shall be 3 exhibitors per Showmanship division or they will move up to the next division to show. If there are not 3 exhibitors for the senior division, then they will show in the Breeding showmanship after the Breeding Show on Friday.
16. All generator uses shall be approved by Livestock Committee.
