

TREASURER OF THE YEAR AWARD

1. Must submit the Missouri 4-H Club Treasurer's Record Book, Y672. It should be filled out completely, correctly and neatly.
2. Also, submit at least two paragraphs, but not more than one page, double spaced, word processed, typed or hand written by the treasurer.
 - First paragraph to consist of name, club name, age and year in 4-H.
 - Remaining paragraph(s) will tell what he/she learned and enjoyed about being the club treasurer.
3. The completed Treasurer Award Application is due in August (usually the 4th Thursday), at the same time that the reporter, secretary book, and project medal awards are due.
4. The Treasurer of the Year Award will be presented at the Greene County 4-H Recognition Night, usually held in October.
