What is SPIN Club?

4-H Special Interest Club, or “SPIN” Club, is a way for youth who want to learn about a specific subject to connect with their peers who have similar interests and adult volunteers who are experienced in that area.

What topics will there be?

It varies, depending on our volunteers’ areas of expertise and what youth are interested in learning. Sports, nature, science, art, music, dance; there are lots of possibilities!

How long will it last?

SPIN Clubs will meet for at least six hours total, typically in 1-1½ hour sessions which occur weekly or every other week.

Who can participate, and how big are the groups?

SPIN is open to anyone currently enrolled in 4-H as well as those who are new to 4-H and would just like to enroll in a SPIN experience. The suggested maximum number of participants in each club is 12, and the required minimum is 5.
