HATCHING CHICKS IN THE CLASSROOM

If your students are interested in a science project for the classroom, none can be more interesting and informative than "Hatching Chicks in the Classroom". Students observe the development of the chick in the egg, hatching, and post-hatch care.

MATERIALS AVAILABLE

INCUBATORS - Incubators may be rented through our office for a cost. The incubators will be delivered to your school shortly before your session and picked up shortly after hatch. There are only a limited number available for rent, so register early!

FERTILE/PRE-INCUBATED EGGS - It requires 21 days to hatch fertile chicken eggs; however, these eggs are pre-incubated at a hatchery. The project, therefore, takes only 7 days to complete. Because of the schedule, no turning is required throughout the weekend.

RESOURCE BOOKS - Books may be ordered at a cost of \$8.00/each. Choose Book #1 - *Hatching Classroom Projects* (Grades 2-5) **and/or** Book #2 - *Experiments in Poultry Science* (Grades 6-8).

CHICK EMBRYO DEVELOPMENT POSTER - This full-color educational poster displays the six stages of growth of a chick inside the egg over an 18-day cycle. Simple vocabulary is used to describe what is happening at each stage. There is an additional charge for this poster and **no orders can be processed after February 4, 2011.**
