

Dear Knox County 4-H Families:

4-H Achievement Day will be here before you know it! It will take place Sunday, April 23, 2017. The event will be held from 1-5 p.m. in the Knox County High School cafeteria. Along with this letter is a registration form. **The form must be turned in to the Extension office by Thursday April 13 at 4:30 p.m.** There is no limit on the number of things you are able to register for. Join us and participate in as many things as you would like! The following things will be available for participation: creative table setting, demonstrations, collections, public judging, and personal development. Achievement Day is to prepare kids and help them obtain life skills. We encourage everyone to participate in at least one event to help us kick off this event as we bring it back to our county 4-H program.

Creative Table Setting:

Choose the occasion and then plan a menu and display one place setting. For a table setting, you must include dishware and silverware that is appropriate to your occasion and menu. Detailed information is available at the extension office. Limit ONE table setting per member. You will need to provide your own 36 in. x 36 in. card table to display your table setting.

Demonstrations:

The same criteria applies as royalty demonstrations. You must include a poster. NO live animals.

Collections:

This can include any collection that you may have. It does not have to be related to your 4-H project. Have your collection organized and presentable. Be prepared to talk to a judge about your collection. You will need to provide your own table to display your collection.

Public Judging:

There will be posters of scenarios that you must judge and provide your reasoning. Example: If I were going to the beach, which shoe would be appropriate to wear (3 options provided). Put the shoes in the order that you think would be best from most suitable to least suitable and then your reasons behind placing them in that order.

Personal Development:

This will be divided in on 3 categories: self-introduction, attitude, and personal appearance. Participants will be judged on an interview with a judge on grooming habits, attitude, personal appearance, and interview. You should be prepared to introduce yourself, the same as you would for a demonstration, and then be able to tell the judge about hobbies, your favorite 4-H projects, school subjects, etc. Proper posture and eye contact are important. You will also need to dress based on a certain occasion and be able to discuss your attire with the judge.
