## 4-H ACTIVITY ACCEPTANCE FORM

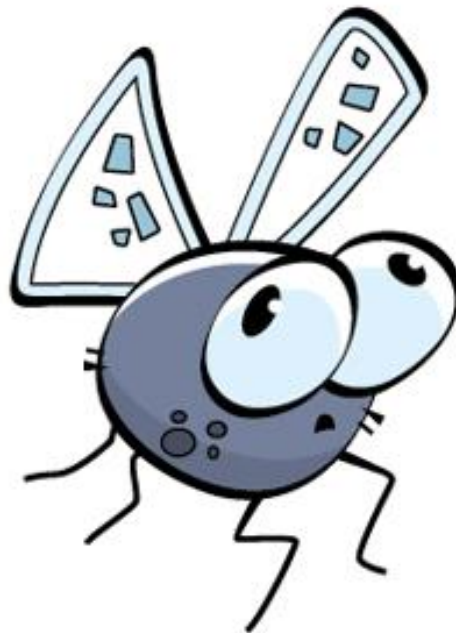
