Clover Kids Corner

Shaking Ice Cream

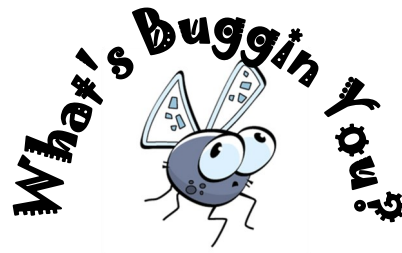
Yield: 1 small serving of ice cream

Materials: $\frac{1}{2}$ cup milk; 1 tbsp. sugar; $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. vanilla extract (or strawberry or other flavoring); 2 cups crushed ice; 3 tbsp. rock salt

Other Things: Measuring cup, Measuring spoons, Pint-size baggie (Ziploc type), Gallon-size baggie (Ziploc type), plastic spoon

Directions:

1. Help children measure $\frac{1}{2}$ cup milk, 1 tbsp. sugar and $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. vanilla extract (or other flavoring) into a pint-size zip-able baggie. Squeeze out as much air as possible before sealing the baggie.
2. Place the pint-size zip-able baggie inside the gallon-size zip-able baggie. Add 2 cups crushed ice and 3 tbsp. rock salt to the gallon-size baggie. Squeeze the air out before sealing.
3. Have children shake the gallon-size baggie vigorously for several minutes. Let them problem solve the best way to do this: they may decide to work in teams, take turns individually, wrap the baggie in something to keep their hands from getting too cold, etc. When the ice cream is of the desired consistency, remove the pint-size baggie from the gallon-size baggie and rinse it in clean water to remove the salt. Open the bag and eat!
