**FOODS/BREADS/FOOD PRESERVATION**

1. **Any recipe may be used, but a recipe card must be attached on an index card with exhibit.**
2. Food exhibits must be food of reasonable keeping quality made within one day of exhibit time.
3. Educational displays may be comprised of posters (limited to 11”x 14” in size and 3-dimensional), note books, file cards, etc.
4. Exhibits comprised of small items such as cookies, muffins, etc. must be exhibited 4 per disposable plate.
5. Cakes, breads, etc. may be exhibited in portions from 1/4 to 1/3 of the total product.
6. A separately wrapped sample, for the judge to taste, should accompany each item.
7. **Food Preservation:** Each item must be accompanied by an index card or label that outlines procedures and recipes used in processing and date of processing.

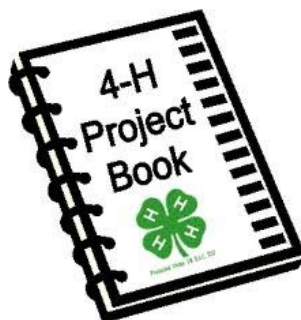
