Performance Tested Bull Sale

Dear Prospective Consignor:

Consignments for the 47th Northeast MO Performance Tested Bull Sale are due **January 21, 2019**.

The sale will be Saturday, March 30, 2019, at F&T Livestock Market, Palmyra, Mo.

This year bulls born Jan. 1, 2017 to Feb. 28, 2018 will be eligible. If entering a yearling bull, weigh off test before returning entry form and consignment fee, so all information can be included. Entry requirements for the sale are on the back of this letter. Note the EPD requirements for the sale. Yearling weights and measurements must be taken by a University of Missouri Extension Field Specialist in Livestock.

Weighing and grading will commence by 7:30 a.m. the day of the sale. All bulls must be in the barn by 7:00 a.m. The sale will start at 1:00 p.m. Bulls do not have to be halter broke to lead but must be trimmed and clean. Provide all the required information asked for on the entry blanks enclosed. Current EPD's on all bulls consigned will be updated before cataloging. As a result, it is very important that registration numbers are included on each entry. The bull sale board of directors encourages ultrasound information in the catalog.

If extra entry forms are needed, they can be found on the website www.nemobeef.com, or call (573) 985-3911 to have them mailed.

A semen test within 60 days of the sale date is required with a certificate signed by the testing veterinarian. A test for Brucellosis (Bangs) within 60 days of the sale date is required or be from Certified Free Herd. Bulls must receive a leptospirosis vaccination. Bulls must be tested and receive a negative test for BVD/PI and this must be indicated on their health paper.

*****All bulls purchased after February 1st, 2019 for use as natural service sires in the Show-Me-Select Replacement Heifer Program™ must be DNA tested to have genomic-enhanced EPDs.*****

Requirements to Be Eligible for the Sale:

Yearling weights and measurements must be taken by a University of Missouri Extension Field Specialist in Livestock.

Bulls do not have to be broke to lead but should be trimmed and clean.

Age: Born between Jan.1, 2017 & Feb. 28, 2018

Bulls must be in the **upper 50th percentile** for 2 out of 4 traits:
BW or CE, WW, YW, and Milk

EPD's - Upper 50th Percentile (this table is to serve as a reference, individual EPD's are subject to change according to breed association percentile tables)

Bulls must be at least 1/2 bloods and be recordable in their breed association and meet all EPD requirements.

Health – Each bull must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Papers).

- Tested and negative for BVD/PI
- Tested and negative for Brucellosis (within 60 days of sale) or be from certified free herd
- Vaccinated for leptospirosis
- Trichomoniasis (trich) testing:
 - Any bull over 24 months of age must be trich tested (negative)
 - Any non-virgin bull must be trich tested (negative)
 - Virgin bull <24 months of age does not require testing
 - Testing performed within 30 days of sale
- Semen Test within 60 days of sale
