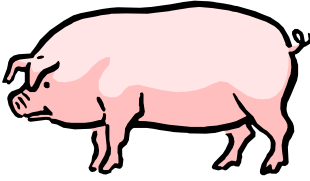
**Mercer County Swine Rules:**

ALL MISSOURI STATE FAIR RULES APPLY UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED!  
ALL SWINE MUST BE CHECKED IN UPON ARRIVAL AT FAIR GROUNDS.  
HEALTH PAPERS AND REGISTRATION MUST BE AVAILABLE UPON  
REQUEST.

All exhibitors must be members in good standing of their respective clubs.

1. Exhibitor must be able to handle livestock. Swine Committee will rule when an Exhibitor is unable to handle livestock safely.
2. Swine shows are open to all 4-H and FFA members in the State of Missouri. The open Junior Swine Show is open to any youth under 8 years of age as of January 1.
3. All breeds eligible to show at State Fair are eligible in breeding classes at this show. If a class is not offered one will be made.
4. All animals shown as purebred in breed classes must have registration papers on file at the fair office. Lack of papers means the animal must show in the appropriate crossbred class. Photocopies of registration papers are acceptable, with the originals on demand.
5. All livestock will be in compliance with the state health regulation, if any, as required by the MO Department of Veterinary Division, check with local Veterinarian.
6. Pen/stall fees must accompany registration. They are Swine \$1.00 per head.
7. Exhibitor is responsible for clean up. Premium monies will not be paid until each exhibitor has cleaned his/her stall area and tie out area.
8. All livestock that leave the grounds prior to the release date specified by the schedule without approval of the division superintendent will not be eligible for premium money or other prizes.
9. Mercer County Swine exhibitors must have their livestock in place by 6 pm the night of the show, Out-of-county livestock must be in place by 6 pm the night of the show as well.
10. Gilts may show in market class, but the same gilts are not eligible to be shown in breeding classes.
11. Grievances and complaints will only be accepted if in writing and signed. These must be submitted to the chairperson before the show starts. Fair Board decisions are final.
