

MONITEAU COUNTY 4-H COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP

1. The Moniteau 4-H Council scholarship is established with the sole purpose of assisting active 4-H members with funding for higher education. Recipient must be graduating from high school and belong to a Moniteau County Club.
2. The County Youth Specialist will manage the scholarship. He/She will make sure that the availability of the scholarship is announced in the 4-H newsletter. He/She will be responsible for appointing a committee to select the recipient(s). This committee will not have an affiliation with Moniteau County.
3. Application and selection will be made through the same procedure used for State 4-H scholarships. You can find the application and the criteria for selection on the State 4-H and county web page. Only applicants that meet the criteria for selection will be considered for this scholarship.
4. Applications will be due to the County Youth Specialist on the same date as the deadline for the State 4-H scholarship each year. The club leader must sign the application in order to verify that the contents of the application are true to the best of their knowledge.
5. The amount and the number of the awards will depend on the availability of funds from year to year. However, the minimum amount per award will be \$500.
6. Recipients must attend an accredited two or four year university, community college, or career and technical school the semester immediately following the issuance of the award.
7. Applicants who are not awarded a State 4-H scholarship will be given 1st preference in receiving this scholarship.
8. An alternate will be chosen in the event that the original recipient does not attend college the semester immediately following the issuance of the award.
9. The award will be given at the annual Scholarship and Award Night at the school the recipient(s) attends. The student is expected to attend this function.
10. The student(s) will be given the scholarship money award upon proof of enrollment being shown to the scholarship chairperson. This needs to be in the form of a letter of acceptance from the college they are attending along with their schedule of classes for 1st semester.
