Fall Contest Day Events

Fashion Revue (September) Provides an opportunity for clothing, knitting, and crochet members to model their garments. One contestant per county is eligible to attend in each category: Clothes You Make, Junior Division; Clothes You Make, Senior Division; Clothes You Buy; Knitted Garment; Crocheted Garment. Participants are chosen at the County Fashion Revue (April).

Livestock Judging Contest (September) Provides competition in both senior and junior divisions. Teams are chosen at the contest held at Ozark Empire Fair. Top senior wins a trip to National Livestock Judging, American Royal, or Denver Western.

Public Speaking Contest (September) This contest is open to all 4-H members. Two members per county in senior and junior divisions are eligible to participate. Participants are chosen at County Achievement Day. They are eligible to compete at Regional Achievement Day as well as at the state contest.

Shooting Sports Contest (September) Contests are held in the following areas: trap, archery, air & pellet, muzzle loading, .22 rifle, and .22 pistol. Team and individual contests are held in senior and junior divisions.

Spring Contest Day Events

Horse Judging Contest (April) One junior and one senior team per county are eligible to participate. This event provides members an opportunity to demonstrate horse judging skills. The top senior team wins a trip to the Eastern Horse Round-up in Louisville, KY

Horse Bowl (April) Team and individual awards. Top senior team to the Eastern Horse Round-Up held in Louisville, Ky. Partial funding is available for this trip.

Hippology (April) Team and individual awards. Top senior team to the Eastern Horse Round-Up held in Louisville, Ky. Partial funding is available for this trip.

Horse Public Speaking (April) Open to junior and senior 4-H members. No limit on the number of participants per county
